Thank you for your correspondence of 18 August 2023 regarding the proposed Woodlawn Advanced Recovery Centre (WARC) and our correspondence of 8 December 2022. We note your invitation to attend a meeting with you on 28<sup>th</sup> August and apologise for the delay in responding.

It is understood you are seeking reconsideration of our assessment of the WARC Environmental Impact Statement where it was considered the proposal would not have adverse impacts on agricultural land uses in the locality.

While DPI Agriculture does not have any regulatory involvement in this project and we have not been further consulted on this matter, our view on the project has not changed since the EIS exhibition.

It is noted that the DPE Major Projects website indicates the proposal is still being assessed, with advice that three independent experts in the fields of energy from waste technology and waste management, human health risk and odour have been engaged to assist in the assessment.

Further, the project will need to be consistent with the EPA's Energy from Waste Policy Statement and NSW Government's Energy from Waste Infrastructure Plan (2021), as well as a range of other matters including the public interest.
